

Adray Metro Playoff Mite Format

2 Classifications: Upper 6 & Lower 7

Upper 6 will play for 1 of 2 spots in the Metro Mite State Finals

Lower 7 will play for an Adray Metro Mite Championship

Metro State Playoff Format

Top 6 teams in points will play for 1 of 2 spots to represent Mite Metro Division in the Adray State Playoffs. Points are as follows; 2 points for a win, 1 for a tie & 0 for a loss. The Playoff format is double elimination, with the following criteria for seeding:

1. Regular season total points
2. Head to Head
3. Goal differential
4. Coin toss

Home Team

The higher seed will have the first option for a home game but if they do not have ice available then the lower seed can provide the ice. If either team does not have ice available then the two teams will work together to arrange a sheet of ice. This process will be in place for games leading up to the semi-final round and the cost will be split between the teams. The semi and final games will be played on neutral ice.

Period Length

9 Minute stop time.

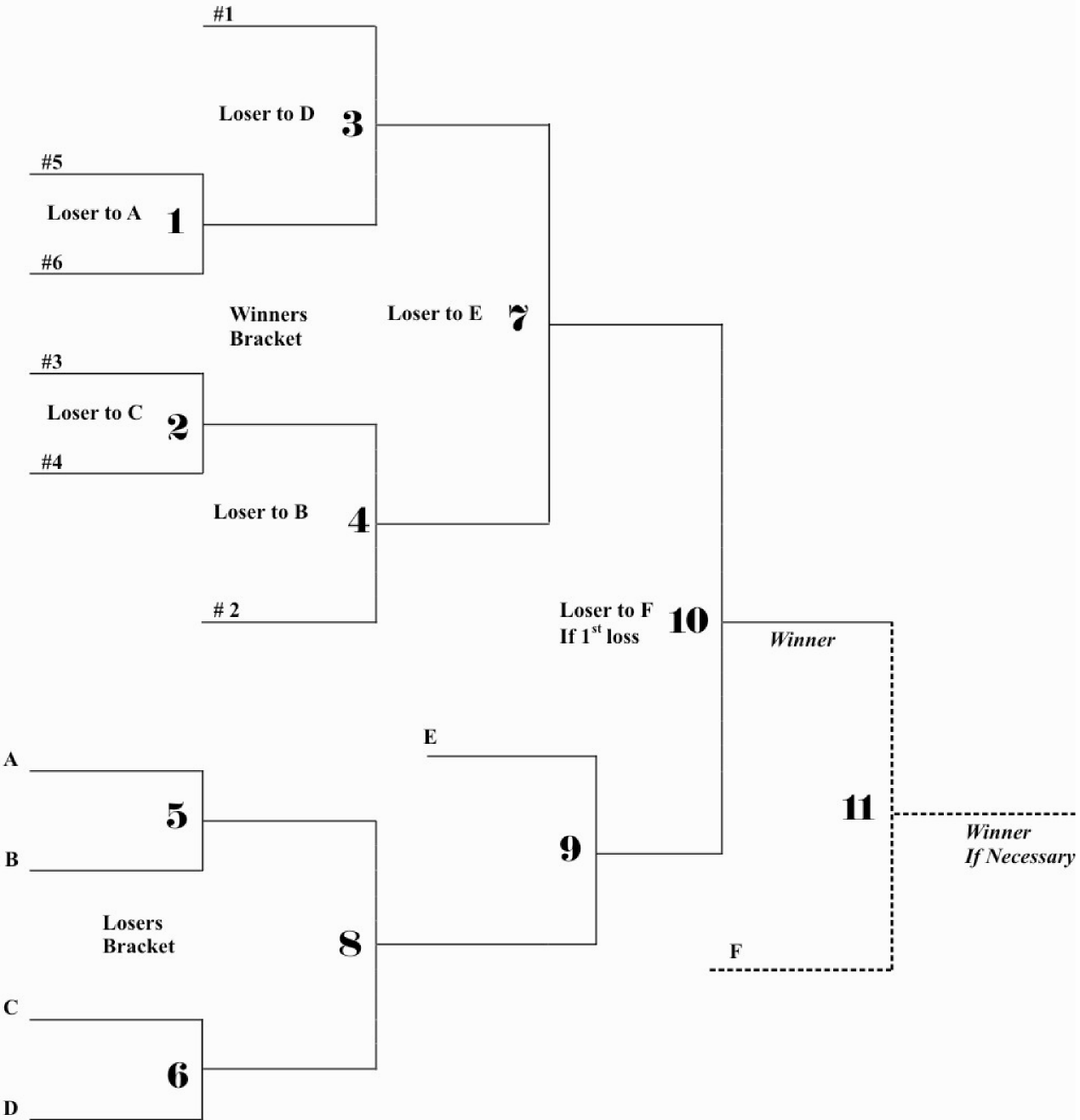
Tie Game Procedure in semi or finals only.

1. 3 players from each team will be selected for a shoot out. A coin toss will determine which team shoots first; the home team calls the toss. Teams alternate shooters.
2. Each team will send one player at a time until one team scores and the other does not or until the time runs out. Each player can only shoot once with exception of the goalie, until all players have shot.
3. Coin toss.

Game Time Frames

First round must be completed by Feb 15th 2009, Second round must be completed by Feb 22nd 2009 and the Championship is March 5th 2009.

Metro Mite Championship Format

Lower 7 teams in points will play a modified Round Robin tournament for the Mite Metro Champion. Points are as follows; 2 points for a win, 1 for a tie & 0 for a loss. The Playoff format is modified Round Robin, with the following criteria for seeding:

1. Regular season total points
2. Head to Head
3. Goal differential
4. Coin Toss

Divisions

There will be 2 divisions;

Division A consists of seeds: #1, #3, #5 & #7

Division B of seeds: #2, #4, & #6 (Division B will have a semi-final game to determine who plays in the championship).

Home Team

The higher seed will have the first option for a home game but if they do not have ice available then the lower seed can provide the ice.
