Regular Season

Starts – Monday, November 19th, 2018

Ends – Thursday, February 8th, 2019

- Regular Season will comprise of 4 Divisions from teams records from pre-season.
- Division Teams 1 and 2 will play each other Home and Away League games (18 games).
- Divisions 3 and 4 will play each other Home and Away League games (16 games).

Post Season 1st Round
Game Format Round Robin Playoff Rules in each Division

1. **Games will be played under the following time format:**
Prep/JV – Three 15-minute Periods – No Overtime
2. **Five (5) second drop of puck rule in effect for all games – USA Rule 611(a)**
3. **One 60 second timeout will be allowed for each team.**
4. **Running Clock:**
In the 3rd Period if the goal differential reaches 6 goals, the game clock goes to running clock. If the differential drops to 4 goals, the game clock returns to a stop time clock.
5. **Standings shall be determined on the following basis:**
Win – 2 points
Tie – 1 Point
Loss – 0 Points
After all Playoff Games played and two or more teams have equal number of points then see tie-breaker format rules.
All Semi-Final and Championship games will take the same format.
6. **The home team will Schedule & Pay the Referees for the Playoff Game.**
Referees will be contracted by The Prep League.
7. **Game Misconducts Received.**
Game Misconduct(s) received during the Playoff Game must be served in the next scheduled Playoff Game which may also include the semi-final and championship game.

Playoff Tiebreaker Rules

After all Playoff Games played and two or more teams have equal number of points then the following tie-breaker format. If one tie-breaker establishes a position for one or more teams, each team is placed in the applicable position. Once a team is placed, the remaining tied teams shall start the tie-breaking process over again.

The Tie-Breaker Formulas are as follows:

1. Most wins in Playoff **Head to Head Games**.
2. Goal Differential in all Playoff Games.
 - A. (6) Points Max Goal Differential per Game.
 - B. Least Goals Against in **ALL** Playoff Games.
 - C. Most Goals Scored in **ALL** Playoff Games.
 - D. Least Penalty Minutes in all Playoff Games.
 - E. Coin Toss by two Prep League Directors present along with the head coach from each tied team present.

Prep League Post Season Format

1. **Game will be played under the following time format:**
Prep/JV – Three 15 minute Periods – Overtime Permitted
2. **Round Robin With In Each Championship**
3. **Five (5) second drop of puck rule in effect for all games – USA Rule 611(a)**
4. **One 60 second timeout will be allowed for each team during semi-final games.**
5. **Running Clock:**
In the 3rd Period if the goal differential reaches 6 goals, the game clock goes to running clock. If the differential drops to 4 goals, the game clock returns to a stop time clock.

Championship Game Format

- 1. Game will be played under the following time format:**
Prep/JV – Three 15 minute Periods – Overtime Permitted
- 2. Five (5) second drop of puck rule in effect for all games – USA Rule 611(a)**
- 3. One timeout (60 Seconds) per team allowed during the Championship Game. Timeout does not carry over into overtime.**
- 4. Running Clock:**
In the 3rd Period if the goal differential reaches 6 goals, the game clock goes to running clock. If the differential drops to 4 goals, the game clock returns to a stop time clock.
- 5. Championship Game that end in a tie after regulation play shall follow the following Overtime Rules:**
 - 5 Minute period(s) sudden death overtime until winner is determined. This process will repeat.
 - Teams **DO NOT** change ends during overtime.
 - All penalties being served at the end of Regulation Play **WILL** carry over into overtime.
- 6. Adray will Schedule & Pay the Championship Game.**
- 7. Coin Toss will determine the home team for the Championship Game.**
